
Learn to WRITE CHINESE

One important element to writing Chinese symbols is a specific order of strokes. Just like writing a word in English, you would never start with the last letter first. Every stroke in the symbol represents a part of the word, so it's important to write each symbol in the order it was intended. For each symbol, try your hand at writing the symbol for yourself – don't forget to follow the steps.



FORTUNE COOKIE Folding Activity


MATERIALS:

- Colored or patterned scrapbook, construction, or origami paper
- A 4-5 inch round object (like an empty & dry cup from Panda)
- Glue or glue gun • Scissors • Pen

Fortune cookies are a staple in American Chinese restaurants, especially Panda Express. Unlike other cookies, they have a fortune inside! When you've run out of yummy fortune cookies from Panda, why not make your own (though not as yummy) to share with family and friends? You can even stuff them with your own fortunes!



Place your round object down on your paper and trace a circle, then cut it out.



Flip the circle over, add a dot of glue, and roll it up like shown.




Grab one of your own fortunes and slide it into the cookie, then turn the cookie so that the seam is on one side. Take the open edges, and bend them together. The center will crease and the cookie shape will form.



Add a dot of glue about an inch away from the center crease, and press the two halves together. It's finished and ready to share! Can you see the fortune inside? Just slide it right out to read – no need to break the cookie.





Color and cut out your own horse mask!




Make a band to wear your horse mask!

Draw Your Own **CELEBRATION**




